

Pickerington Preschool Emergency Medical Authorization

(Excerpts from O.R.C. Section 3313.712)

- This emergency medical authorization form enables parents to authorize emergency treatment for children who become ill or injured while under school authority, when parents cannot be reached.
- If a parent does not wish to give such written permission, s/he shall indicate in the proper place on the form the procedure s/he wishes authorities to follow in the event of a medical emergency involving her/his son/daughter.
- Even if a parent gives written consent for emergency medical treatment, when a child becomes ill or is injured and requires emergency medical treatment while under school authority, or while engaged in an extra-curricular activity authorized by the appropriate authorities, the authorities of the school shall make reasonable attempts to contact the parent before treatment is given. The school shall present the child's emergency medical authorization form or copy thereof to the hospital or practitioner rendering treatment.
- Nothing in this section shall be construed to impose liability on any school official or employee who in good faith, attempts to comply with this section.
