



**PICKERINGTON LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
60-Day Waiver - CHANGE OF CUSTODY STATUS**

In order to be eligible for a tuition-free, public education in the Pickerington Local School District, a student’s custodial/residential parent or guardian must be a resident of our district. In the absence of judge-signed documentation, and in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 3313.64, an adult resident of the Pickerington Local School District must submit proof that legal residential custody or legal guardianship proceedings have been initiated through the court. The following is required to enroll under this provision: (1) a Motion to Change/Amend Custody that has been time-stamped by a court. **AND** (2) a notarized letter stating the current residential parent is aware the child lives with you, is enrolling in Pickerington Schools, and understands a change of custodial/residential parent or guardian is in the process; **AND** (3) a copy of the registering parent’s photo driver’s license or State ID card. The student can then be admitted to the district and attend for a period not to exceed 60 calendar days. Prior to day #61 (see date indicated below) we **MUST** receive the finalized, judge-signed court document showing you have been granted legal residential custody of the student.

IMPORTANT: Please submit your judge-signed residential custody documents to the Welcome Center. If the District does not receive the necessary documents, your student will be automatically **WITHDRAWN** on the 61st calendar day and cannot return to school.
