

## PICKERINGTON LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT 90-Day Waiver – NON-RESIDENCY STATUS

In order to be eligible for a tuition-free, public education in the Pickerington Local School District, a student's custodial/residential parent or guardian must be a resident of our district. Ohio Revised Code 3313.64(F)(7) and PLSD Board Policy 5111 allow for the enrollment of a student whose parent(s) is building or buying a home in our district. The initial requirement would be a purchase agreement on showing intent to relocate. The student will be admitted to the district and attend for a tuition-free period not to exceed 90 calendar days.

If you have not provided the Welcome Center with evidence that you have established residency of this new address, your student will be automatically **WITHDRAWN** on the 91st calendar day and cannot return to school until you provide the district with the necessary residency documentation. (An extension could be granted if you provide the Welcome Center with a written statement from the builder outlining the delay in the closing process.)
